Source manuscript

The original lease book is held in the private library of the Earl of Derby at Knowsley Hall under reference C24 (formerly H45). It is a bound manuscript volume of around 60 vellum folios.

There have been several mentions of this Lease Book in important Manx histories. It was loaned by Lord Derby to the Manx Society in 1861 and was expected then to be transcribed and published in a future publication (see Manx Soc Pub XXIV). For some reason this never occured however.

Additionally Dr. Roger Dickinson has researched the legal and financial context of the Lease Book and the publication of his findings is awaited with interest.

Transcriber's Notes

This transcription was made from my high resolution photographs of the original manuscript. It is a literal transcription in that I have retained the original pagination, spelling and abbreviations.
